

## **2010 ROCKIES MAIL DROP LOCATIONS AND INFORMATION**

Friends and family,

Texas 4000 uses “mail drops” at selected locations along our route, so that riders can get care packages and letters from those close to them. It’s always nice to receive things from people back home, but please keep a few things in mind:

- Be sure to include **Texas 4000 and the Rider's name** on the package.
- Make sure the package **will arrive on time**, as we cannot burden our hosts with forwarding packages ahead to the next mail drop location. We **cannot** ask them to do this. Please mail your packages by the date indicated for each mail drop. Mailing packages after that deadline risks damaging our relationship with our hosts. Please do not inconvenience them.
- Follow **specific instructions** outlined for each mail drop, as different rules apply for some.
- Please think about what you send, as we have limited room in the van and the trailer. **We cannot haul big items**, because we are already pressed for space.
- **Do not send perishable items across the border.** In the past, we had a host rack up a healthy amount of fines because of food a T4K member’s friend tried to send into Canada.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation. As an organization, we strive to maintain good relations with our hosts and contacts throughout the year and following these rules will ensure that no one gets upset with us. That said, don’t be intimidated by the rules!
