**TEXAS 4000 FOR CANCER PRESENTS DONATION TO
MD ANDERSON CANCER CENTER
*\$295,000 to be donated by the 2009 team***

Austin, TX (March 22, 2010) – On Thursday, March 25th at 2 p.m., the 2009 Texas 4000 for Cancer team will present their donation of \$295,000 to MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, TX. A portion of the donation will complete the organization’s commitment to fulfill a Distinguished Professorship Endowment at the cancer center. The remaining \$120,000 has been allocated for the Pediatric Clinical and Translational Research Center at MD Anderson. The presentation will take place at “The Park” at MD Anderson.

Texas 4000 for Cancer team members cycle over 4,500 miles from Texas to Alaska each summer to spread hope, cancer awareness and raise money to support cancer research initiatives such as those found at MD Anderson. Team members raise money by reaching out to friends and family and planning various fundraising events, and the 2009 team proudly raised more than \$360,000.

There will be a celebration happy hour from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on March 25th at Beavers in Houston located at 2310 Decatur Street. Members of both the 2009 and 2010 teams will be present to share their Texas 4000 experience.
