



2016 Sierra Mail Drops

Friends and Family,

Texas 4000 uses “mail drops” at selected locations along our route so that riders may receive care packages and letters from friends and family. It’s always nice to receive things from people back home, but please keep a few things in mind when mailing packages:

- Be sure to send the package to the specific address with “Texas 4000: Rider’s Name” at the top, as you will see below!
- As we shouldn’t burden our host with the responsibility of our packages after our arrival, please ensure your package arrives on time by mailing them by the specified date. If a package arrives after our stay, the host reserves the right to discard or enjoy whatever goodies are inside!
- Please consider what you mail; we cannot haul large items because we are pressed for space in our vans and trailer.
- Do not send perishable items across the US/Canada border. Our hosts may incur delivery costs if you include perishable items in packages.
DO NOT send any mail signature required. We cannot be responsible for packages delivered while hosts are out, as asking the host to pick up this package on their own time is a significant burden. Please make sure any outside shipping agencies follow this policy.
- For packages going to Canada, be sure to mark the outside as “gifts” so our hosts do not incur customs fees.

As an organization, we strive to maintain good relations with our hosts and contacts throughout the years. Please consider these guidelines before you send any package our way. Below you can find specific mailing addresses for our 10 Mail Drop locations.

2016 Rockies Mail Drops

Friends and Family,

Texas 4000 sets up “mail drops” at select locations along each route so that riders may receive care packages and letters from friends and family. It’s always nice to receive correspondence from loved ones, but please keep a few things in mind when mailing packages:

- When addressing packages, include “Texas 4000: [Rider’s Name]” as the first line as seen below.
- We don’t want to further burden our hosts by placing them responsible for late packages. Please mail packages by the date specified. If a package arrives after riders leave, the host reserves the right to discard or enjoy whatever goodies are inside.
- Please carefully consider what you mail. Do not send large items because we are extremely pressed for space in our vans and trailer.
- Do not send perishable items across the US/Canada border. Our hosts may incur delivery costs if anything perishable is found in a package.
- For packages entering Canada, clearly label the outside as “gifts” so our hosts do not incur customs fees.
- DO NOT send any mail signature required. We cannot be responsible for packages delivered while hosts are out, as asking the host to pick up this package on their own time is a significant burden. Please make sure any outside shipping agencies follow this policy.

As an organization, we strive to maintain good relationships with our hosts and supporters from year to year. Please consider all of these guidelines before sending any packages. 2016 Ozarks Route Mail Drops

Dear friends and family,

Over the years many people have requested the opportunity to send the Texas 4000 riders letters, packages, and necessary items while they are on the ride. To facilitate this, we have asked several of our hosts to accept packages on our behalf and hold them until we arrive.

If you are interested in sending something via a mail drop, please note the following:

- Always indicate that the package is for Texas 4000 *and* the specific rider that it is for. If it is for the whole team, please indicate that as well.
- Please send packages by the dates listed on the following mail drop location sheet. Our hosts do so much for us already and we cannot burden them with the task of forwarding our packages at their own cost.
- If sending a large item, please consider consulting your rider before sending it to ensure that they have space in their duffel bag to carry the item with them. Riders are responsible for making sure that all of their summer belongings take up only their allotted space in our equipment trailer.
- Please ensure that packages sent to Canada will not incur fees when they reach the mail drop host (Ask the post office. Label packages going to Canada as “*gifts*” so that they do not incur customs fees. No food may be sent to Canada – it will incur large fees and possibly be returned to the sender.)
- Cards and letters being sent to Canada require a special international stamp. Please consult with your local post office for the correct stamp. It is suggested that all packages are sent via UPS or FedEx.
- DO NOT send any mail signature required. We cannot be responsible for packages delivered while hosts are out, as asking the host to pick up this package on their own time is a significant burden. Please make sure any outside shipping agencies follow this policy.

Receiving letters of encouragement and small packages will mean the world to us while we’re so far away from home. Thank you so much in advance for thinking of us!
