- Work well with our team of volunteers and riders or solo when needed

5-10 hours/week minimum desired. Internships will span from February 10th – May 15th (exact dates flexible). ## **Events Intern**

The Events Intern will assist the Events Coordinator and Associate Director of Development. Tasks may include:

- Market the ATLAS ride and Tribute Gala
- Create social media posts and marketing emails
- Perform research on vendors for the Finish Line, bike shops, and cycling groups

- Attend monthly ATLAS and Tribute Committee meetings (optional)
- Assist in managing participant fundraisers and creating donor and sponsor tax receipts
- Support the Texas 4000 staff as needed

## **Operations Intern**

The Operations Intern will assist the Operations Manager and Program Staff. Tasks may include:

- Data management in Raiser's Edge, our donor management system
- Program research
- Compile historic info about Texas 4000
- Managing merchandise inventory
- Supporting and preparing for events
- Generating reports
- Website Maintenance
- Managing program inventory (i.e. tools, bike parts, gear)
